Tongue and Scalp Necrosis: Simultaneous Initial Complications Revealing Giant Cell Arteritis. *J Rheumatol* 2018;45:873–4) is of a 66-year-old patient who had fever, bilateral headache, tongue edema, jaw pain and intermittent binocular diplopia with transient amaurosis and bilateral shoulder arthralgia. An erythematous and scabbed rash then developed on the patient's scalp, featuring a necrosis area as shown. Temporal artery biopsy showed GCA.
